Accessing LexisNexis Digital – at an LA Law Library location using public computers

Guest Access

1. Log on to a public computer.
2. Click Legal Research Databases
3. Choose **LexisNexis Digital Library icon**
4. Click **Sign in a Guest**

What's the difference between Guest and Library Card Access?

Guest Access – Available onsite at LA Law Library

- Browse any LexisNexis Digital title regardless if it is checked out or viewed by another patron.
- Keep your place even if you close the browser.
- Erase your place, notes and history if you log out of LexisNexis Digital or if your computer session ends.
 - Search session disappears if you log off LA Law Library computer.

Library Card Access

- Session is unique to your library account.
- Save your Search History, Notes and Annotations.
- Maintain a list of the eBooks you have viewed/checked out.
- Place holds.
- Return eBooks and check out others.
- Access only available materials. If another patron has the eBook checked out, is viewing it or it is on hold, it won't be available to view.

1. Download the LexisNexis Digital Library app from the Google Play™ store or the Apple® App Store.
2. Open the app.
